



# Host a Switch It Sunday

The first Switch It Sunday (happening on the 21st April 2024) is an opportunity for your church to get behind [The Big Bank Switch campaign](#) - by praying for a greener banking sector, sharing information about The Big Bank Switch with your congregation, or reflecting on themes of creation care and an ethical use of money within your service that day.

Hundreds of Christians will be switching to a greener bank in the week following the first Switch It Sunday - the first wave of switches within a year-long campaign. The date for Switch It Sunday has been chosen because of its proximity to Earth Day on 22nd April.

The Big Bank Switch is a collaboration between three Christian organisations - [Just Love](#), [JustMoney Movement](#) and [Operation Noah](#) - that have partnered with [Switch It Green](#) to support Christians across the UK to align their money with their values by switching to greener banks.

**Here are some ideas for getting your church involved in the first Switch It Sunday and The Big Bank Switch.**

### Prayer points:

- For people and communities most affected by the climate crisis
- For banks to play their part in shaping a fairer, greener world
- For banks to phase out the financing of fossil fuels and support a just transition
- For more investment in green energy, housing, transport and food systems
- For greater transparency and an end to 'greenwashing'
- For better regulation of the financial sector to help people and planet flourish

Greenwashing = the practice of misleading consumers about a product's environmental impact or benefits



## Discuss: After the service

**Things to discuss and do over tea and coffee or in house group sessions:**

### Discussion points

Asking people to chat about green banking after a service is a nice way to get your church more involved with the campaign. Here are some discussion prompts to consider:

- How does our money connect us to God's creation and our global neighbours?
- What types of things might we like - or not like - the money in our banks to support?
- How might switching to a green bank align with our Christian values?

### Letter writing

When people switch their bank on the Switch It Green website as part of The Big Bank Switch campaign, they will get access to tailored emails to send to their old bank to let them know why they are leaving. However, getting people to write creative physical letters after a Switch It Sunday service is a great way to engage people with the campaign.

### Switching stories

Some people in your community may already be part of The Big Bank Switch or may have previously switched to a green bank of their own accord. Asking people to share their switching stories verbally can be a great way to support others in their switching journey.
